Teacher notes

This networkable CD-Rom allows many different activities, and can easily be used for most aspects of World War II. It is suitable for Year 10 and 11 pupils. The networked nature of the CD-Rom, together with older pupils means the exercise can be of a more open nature. The task should take about 30-40 minutes, suitable for individuals or groups of 2 pupils. The exercise is not suitable for use on a standalone computer **unless** pupils are given a short time limit (5 minutes) and have to find information on only one or two titles.

Instructions are given how to find information, but then it is up to the pupils to research the CD-Rom. The pupils can read, watch and listen to the information. After the exercise they should have rough notes on the origins of the Second World War. An obvious follow up exercise would be to write this up as notes or use the information to answer a question.

Preparations (N.B. Instructions to not necessarily apply on all networks)

1. Put the CD-Rom into the CD drive, and a start-up screen should appear:
2. Simply click on RUN
3. The instructions provided on the worksheet then apply.
