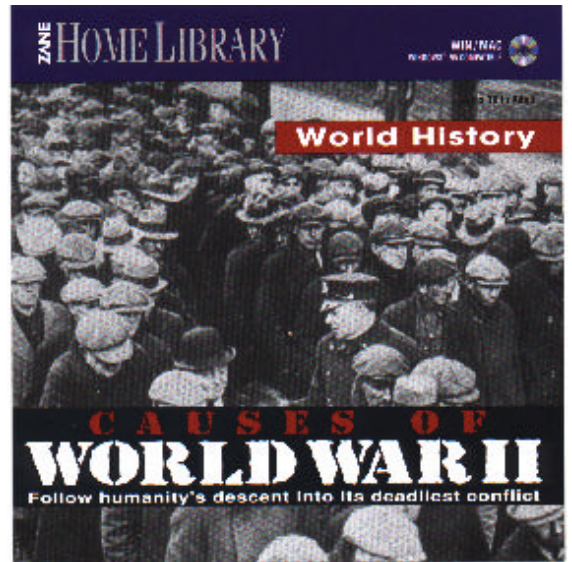


THE CAUSES OF WORLD WAR TWO

Teacher notes


This CD-Rom is suitable for use with Year 9. Made by the same company who produced the Industrial Revolution CD-Rom, the limitations and exercises provided are extremely similar. Again, the CD-Rom contains a great deal about the causes, but a large amount of information is audio based, and often too detailed. For this reason, two functions of the CD-Rom will result in the best classroom use – the Glossary and the Quiz.



Two worksheets are provided with different exercises. One with the glossary exercise, which provides instructions to load and utilise the CD-Rom glossary. The second provides instructions to use the quiz function. Here pupils are presented with visual material, and relevant questions with 4 multiple choice answers. 20 'random-ish' questions are asked in 10 minutes (but most should take under that time). The worksheet is suitable for both single pupils or groups of 3-4, and the computer provides the assessment. An element of competition is available by seeing which groups can get them all correct!

The additional advantage of this CD-Rom is after the quiz. The worksheet directs pupils to investigate their incorrect answers. By following the on-screen instructions they are able to get explanations why their answer was incorrect, and the reasons for the correct answer. This can be an extremely effective learning tool.

Preparations.

1. Put the CD-Rom into the CD drive, and a start-up screen should appear:
2. Simply click on 
3. The worksheets give pupils instructions on how to begin each exercise from the main title screen.



If the start-up screen fails to appear, select  and then  Programs
Then find and click on  PowerCD and select  PowerCD
